Order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellant has been impugned in the present intra-court appeal.

The appellant, who was a candidate for the post of Assistant Professor in the category of Ex-Serviceman, is claiming consideration for the said post. The submission is that vide corrigendum published on 15.3.2016, the condition of percentage of marks in the minimum qualifications was relaxed. Hence, the appellant is even exempted from passing the NET examination for consideration of his candidature.

The learned Single Judge has rightly rejected the petition filed by the petitioner as a perusal of the corrigendum reveals that it gives relaxation only to the extent of possessing minimum marks in the qualification of M.A./ B.A./ Intermediate/ Matriculation, which have been

prescribed in the advertisement. There is no relaxation from passing of NET examination. Admittedly, the appellant has not passed NET examination, hence, cannot be considered eligible.

There is no merit in the present appeal. The same is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
