KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE: (Oral)

After the matter was heard for some time, when confronted with the observation that this is third round of litigation and the award made by Labour Court in favour of the workman was confirmed by the learned single Judge and then by a Division Bench of this Court and thereafter by the Hon'ble Apex Court and thus the writ petition has rightly been dismissed and the present LPA has no legs to stand besides there is an inordinate delay of 770 days in filing this appeal, the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Punjab, finding it difficult to assail the impugned order, upon instructions from Shri Gurjeet Singh, Range Forest Officer, Zira, and Shri Baljeet Singh, Range Forest Officer, Moga, sought leave of the Court to permit withdrawal of the appeal.

Prayer made is allowed.

Appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn.
