RAJESH BINDAL, J.

The order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 09.05.2018 denying interim stay regarding the order of promotion dated 22.03.2018 has been impugned by the appellants by filing the present intra-court appeal.

2. Learned counsel for the appellants submitted that there being no quantifiable data available with the State, there was no question of issuing any policy for grant of promotion to the reserved category candidates and that the earlier policies framed in the absence of quantifiable data had already been set aside by this Court.

3. Be that as it may, as the order of promotion has already been given effect to before it was challenged by filing the writ petition and grant of interim relief at this stage would amount to allowing the writ petition itself i.e. granting final relief, no error is found in the impugned order.

4. Hence the present appeal is dismissed.
