Order dated 10.10.2017 passed by the learned Single Judge whereby at the time of issuance of notice of motion, interim relief was not granted to the appellant, has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal. Along with the appeal, an application for condonation of delay of 202 days in filing of the appeal has also been filed.

The subject matter of dispute is the qualification of the appellant from Council of Secondary Education, Mohali which as on date, undisputedly, is not recognized. This is what has been recorded by the learned Single Judge while declining interim relief to the appellant.

We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, application seeking condonation of delay in filing the appeal is also dismissed.
