For the reasons stated in CM-2345-LPA-2018, delay of 53 days in filing the appeal is condoned and application stands disposed of.

The appellant/petitioner claiming himself to be a victim of 1984 riots approached this Court by filing CWP No.18190 of 2017 seeking the following main reliefs:

“i) Issue a Writ, Order or Direction especially for the issuance of a Writ in the nature of Certiorari for suitably modifying/setting aside the Report submitted by the Hon'ble Commission dated 16.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) whereby in adequate amount of compensation has been recommended to be paid to the Petitioner/Claimant qua loss of property.

ii) Issue of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus commanding upon the Respondents to pay the amount of compensation to the Petitioner/Claimant as per the amount claimed in the Petition.”

The learned Single Judge finding that an identical issue was raised in CWP No.25029 of 2017 titled “**Harbhajan Singh and others v. Union of India and others**” which was dismissed by a learned Single Judge vide order dated 22.11.2017 which was upheld by a Division Bench in LPA No.31 of 2018 vide order dated 18.01.2018, dismissed the writ petition.

Since the issue already stands covered by the decision rendered in LPA No.31 of 2018 titled as **Harbhajan Singh and others v. Union of India and others** dated 18.01.2018, this appeal also stands disposed of in terms of the judgment and order rendered in LPA No.31 of 2018.
