REKHA MITTAL, J.

The present appeal directs challenge against consistent findings recorded by the Courts whereby suit filed by the appellant claiming right in land left behind by Molu son of Nand Singh who died in the year 1950 was dismissed by the trial Court and the judgment and decree passed by the trial Court was affirmed in appeal by the Additional District Judge, Kaithal.

Counsel for the appellant is not in a position to advance any argument much less meaningful to substantiate plea of the appellant that her mother Smt. Daropati could inherit to the estate of her brother Molu in the year 1950 when otherwise the Courts have rejected claim of the appellant being barred by limitation and subsequent purchasers of land being bona fide purchasers thereof. I have also gone through the judgments passed by the Courts but unable to find that the present appeal raises a substantial question of law that requires determination after hearing the contesting parties.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine. No order as to costs.
