Main cases

These two cross-appeals have been filed by the rival parties. An application has been filed for permission with a prayer to dispose of both

the appeals in terms of the written deed of compromise dated 15.01.2018, Annexure A-1 on the record.

Learned counsel for the parties have stated at bar that all the parties are present and they admit the correctness of the deed of compromise. The original deed of compromise has been produced which is taken on record, marked as "C". According to the aforesaid compromise, both the Regular Second Appeals are disposed of. The deed of compromise as translated by the learned counsel for the parties shall form part of the decree.
