In the present appeal, appellant has questioned the validity of orders of trial and appellate courts dated 31.07.2013 and 25.08.2015 respectively. Grievance of the appellant is that he was frequently transferred from one place to another place during the period from 25.10.2004 to 25.08.2009. He has not been extended service benefits like TA/DA as and when he was transferred, annual increment for a period of 01.10.2003 to 01.10.2004 has not been extended and he has been denied advancement of amount of Rs.45,000/- from the GP fund. Trial court in paras 12 to 17 have considered each of the issue with reference to documentary evidence relating to appellant's service book to the extent of extending service benefits. Insofar as withholding of increment, it was noticed that in a disciplinary proceeding he was imposed penalty of withholding of increments. Transfer issue is concerned the appellant has been transferred frequently during the period from 25.10.2004 to 25.08.2009. It was dealt with that from the date of filing of suit appellant has not been displaced. In

view of these facts and circumstances, appellant has not made out any substantial question of law so as to interfere with the decree as well as appellate court decision. Accordingly, appeal stands dismissed.
