It is stated that the costs could not be paid because the appellant No.1 is in jail. In the circumstances, the costs are exempted.

This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the courts below dismissing a suit filed by the appellants. The case of the appellants was that they had inherited the entire property of their father to the exclusion of their two brothers on the basis of a registered Will. Both the courts below held against the appellants primarily on the grounds that the original Will was never placed on record and that the appellants had admitted that the father was not in a sound state of mind. Even otherwise, the appellants have not been able to explain how in the Will it has been mentioned that the other two brothers have been given their share when they were not able to show anything which was given to the other two brothers.

In the circumstances, no fault can be found the judgments of the courts below. Appeal is dismissed. No costs.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
