Appellant was subjected to disciplinary proceedings on the allegation that he had caused pecuniary loss to the respondent-Federation which were concluded in imposing the penalty of recovery. Recovery order was subject matter before the trial court in a civil suit. Trial Court upheld the order of recovery. Feeling aggrieved by the order of the trial court, he had preferred an appeal. Appellate Court affirmed the decision of the trial court. Appellant has not made out a case so as to interfere with the decree as well as order of the appellate court. Prima facie case was not made out so also no error is committed by the courts below.

Accordingly, appeal stands dismissed.
