Pleadings on record indicate that the plaintiff-Ram Sukh filed a suit for permanent injunction against his own father, namely, Ram Sachit seeking a restraint against interference in his peaceful possession over the suit property mentioned as portion of house No.216, situated at Indra Colony, Tripuri Town, Patiala. Suit was dismissed by the trial Court on 08.05.2015 and even a civil appeal preferred by the plaintiff/appellant was dismissed by the learned Additional District Judge, Patiala on 01.02.2016.
