The plaintiffs-appellants are in the regular second appeal against the judgment passed by the learned first appellate court, reversing the judgment and decree passed by the learned trial court.

The plaintiffs through the present suit pray for an issuance of direction to the Electricity Supply Company to shift electricity polls, supporting the wires installed in the land of the plaintiffs.

The learned first appellate court has found that the polls have been installed as per the Scheme prepared and sanctioned by the authority. The court has further found that the aforesaid Scheme has been sanctioned in the larger interest of the public and the plaintiffs if aggrieved are entitled to get compensation.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellants are owners of a small piece of land wherein three polls have been installed.

This Court has no expertise whether one poll is required or more than one poll is required for ensuring supply of electricity. It is only an expert in the field who can opine about it.

The Power Supply Company, which is owned by the Government, has laid the cables for supplying electricity to agriculture sector. Once as per law the plaintiffs are entitled to claim compensation, the first appellate court was correct in reversing the judgment passed by the trial court.

In view of the above, there is no ground to interfere. The present regular second appeal is dismissed. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, in terms thereof.
