This is an application for condonation of 381 days delay in
refiling the appeal.

For the reasons recorded in the application, the same is allowed
and delay of 381 days in refiling the appeal is condoned.

Main Case

This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of
the Courts below dismissing a suit filed by the appellants with respect to
certain land which was jointly owned by father of the appellants and his
brother (and predecessor-in-interest of all the respondents).

Both the Courts below held that in an earlier dispute between
the father of the appellants and the legal representatives of his brother
compromise dated 4.4.1994 had entered into. As per which, the land in
dispute had gone to the legal representatives of the said Nafe Singh. Both

the Courts below further noticed that aforesaid compromise was duly proved by examining the witnesses and the hand writing expert and consequently, dismissed the suit.

Learned counsel is not in a position to explain me how the findings of the Courts below are flawed. The appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
