This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments of the Courts below dismissing a suit filed by the appellant.

The appellant had challenged the sale deed by his late brother in favour of respondents No.2 to 4. He also challenged the status of respondent No.1 as the wife of his late brother.

Both the Courts below held that respondent No.1 had been able to prove that she was the wife of the late brother because they had a child, they had purchased land together and there was documentary evidence in the form of bank accounts etc. where she has been described as a wife.

Once that is so, the appellant had no right to challenge any sale deed of his late brother.

Counsel has not been able to show how the finding regarding the relationship of respondent No.1 with the late brother can be held to be not established.

Appeal stands dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
