AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

On 15.02.2018 the following order was passed :-

“After arguing for some time, counsel for the appellant states that the parties are brothers and the appellant is ready to compensate the respondent but since the fact of the matter is that the respondent has always lived in Delhi and the appellant has built his house on the property in dispute, he prays that the matter be referred to the Mediator. In my opinion, before doing that it would be appropriate to put the appellant to some terms since by the intervention of the court the respondent would have to engage a counsel.

Notice of motion for this limited purpose. Let the respondent be served through his counsel in the Executing Court by way of dasti process. Dasti only. Copy of this order be also annexed with the summons. The appellant is directed to hand-over a draft of Rs.20,000/- in the name of the respondent alongwith the summons.

Adjourned to 08.03.2018.

Today respondent is present in person with his counsel and states that there is no possibility of mediation.

In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
