Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the present appeals have been rendered infructuous in as much as the impugned awards are dated 19.03.2015 and 20.03.2015 of the Reference Court, Rewari and the same are based on award dated 26.02.2015 in LA Case No.1212 of 2010 titled as **Ashok Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others** wherein an amount of Rs.16,00,000/- per acre has been granted to the landowners in view of acquisition dated 02.12.2005.

It is further submitted by the counsel for the appellants that in RFA No.3619 of 2015 titled as **HSIIDC Vs. Ashok Kumar and others** and connected matters decided on 07.04.2017, the matters were remanded to the Reference Court for a fresh decision.

It is further submitted that in pursuance of the said remand, the Reference Court has passed a fresh award.

Accordingly, the appeals are dismissed having become infructuous.
