Appellant has questioned the concurrent finding given by both the courts below.

Grievance of the appellant is that he has not been paid appropriate salary during three spells i.e. 1985 to 1990, 1992 and 1995. However, appellant has not produced any material to show that he has been paid lesser salary than the salary attached to the post. No substantial question of law arises in the present appeal so as to entertain the appeal in view of the decision passed by the Supreme Court in the case of Satish Chand v. Kailash Chand; (2017) 13 SCC 619.

Accordingly, appeal stands dismissed.
