This appeal has been filed against the concurrent judgments and decrees of the courts below decreeing a suit for mandatory injunction filed by the respondent.

On 16.02.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Counsel for the appellant seeks more time to implead the LR's of the respondent. I find that last opportunity to implead the LR's was granted to the appellant on 25.09.2017. Though there is no justification for adjournment yet on the request of the counsel, the matter is adjourned to 16.03.2018 subject to payment of costs of Rs.2000/- to be paid in favour of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.”

On 16.03.2018 the following order was passed:-

“Neither costs have been paid nor application has been moved in terms of order dated 16.02.2018. None has entered appearance on behalf of the appellant.

Adjourned to 20.03.2018.”

Today the counsel for the appellant states that despite his best efforts the appellant has not responded to his messages.

In the circumstances, the appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
