Learned State counsel seeks permission to withdraw the present
appeal. He is permitted to do so.

2. Accordingly, RSA stands dismissed as withdrawn.
3. Heard cross objection. Learned counsel for the respondent submitted that during pendency of the RSA, respondent have passed an order of reinstatement. Thus, there is compliance to the decree passed on 17.07.2014. Therefore, present cross-objection do not survive for consideration. Ultimately what is required to be examined in the cross-objection is whether decree has been complied or not? Undisputedly, there is compliance. If respondent is not happy with the compliance to the decree in that event she has a remedy. Thus, present cross-objection do not survive for consideration in view of the compliance of the decree read with withdrawal of the RSA.
