Learned counsel for the parties admit that the parties have settled their dispute. A copy of the order passed on 19.03.2018 by the learned Executing Court has been produced, which is extracted as under:-

“File taken up today as an application to withdraw the execution as per compromise. Main case file summoned from record room. Learned counsel for the Jds has endorsed 'no objection' on the restoration of execution petition to its original number. Heard. In view of 'no objection' endorsed by Learned counsel for the Jds, present execution be restored to its original number. Both the parties are present in the court and stated that matter has been compromised. The Decree Holder released a statement that she has received Rs.20 Lakhs/-. DH also stated that she withdraws the present execution and a prayer for refund of court fee has also been made.

JDs have also stated that they have no objection in returning the court fee to the DH. Both the parties are duly identified by their counsel.

Heard. Keeping in view the statement made above, present execution petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. File be consigned to record room, after due compliance.”

In view of the aforesaid order, the appeal is rendered infructuous and is dismissed.
