KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Suit filed by plaintiffs for directing the defendant-Senior Superintendent of Post Office, Head Post Office, Ferozpur Road, Ludhiana Division, Ludhiana to disclose the status report of seven registered covers posted vide speed post by the plaintiff on 26.8.2011 and 27.8.2011 was dismissed by both the Courts below.

Heard.

I am of the view that through the suit an information has been sought which could be sought from the postal department through Right to Information Act, 2005 since the efficacious remedy was available, therefore, the suit was otherwise not maintainable.

As such, present appeal is dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to move an application under Right to Information Act, 2005 to seek information from the postal department.

Dismissed with liberty aforesaid.

Since, the main appeal has been dismissed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, shall stand disposed of.
