AJAY TEWARI, J.(ORAL)

Today, only the application for stay is listed but with consent of parties main case is taken up on board today itself.

The appellant and the respondents along with their counsel are present. With the intervention of learned counsel for the parties, this dispute has been settled. The appellant has agreed that even during the turn of their family one member of the respondent's family/ies can sit on the *Gaddi* and distribute the *Parshad*.

On instructions from respondent, counsel for the respondent has accepted that in lieu of this concession they would have no objection if the family members of appellant take Management of Gurdwara and take their turn as per the turn of their father.

Counsel for the respondents further stipulate that during the period of the turn of the appellant and her family,

they should ensure that the management and *Maryada* of the Gurdwara is followed and this has been accepted by the appellant. Counsel for the appellant have accepted this on the condition that whatever offerings are made during their turn, should be scrupulously handed over to them including those which may be given to the respondents and that though in the month of November it was the turn of the appellant's family yet to facilitate the settlement, they are ready to give up their claim for the remainder of this turn which was to end on 30th of November. The respondents have accepted this.

In view of this agreed order, the appeal is disposed of.
