Defendant-appellants, are in regular second appeal against concurrent finding of fact arrived at by the Courts below while decreeing suit for permanent injunction against defendants restraining them from interfering in any manner in the possession of the plaintiffs from land measuring 20 Kanals and 8 marlas detail whereof has been given in the plaint. Defendants contested the suit and pleaded that they are in possession and the correctness of stand of the plaintiff was disputed. Both the Courts on appreciation of evidence have concurrently found that the plaintiffs have successfully proved their case whereas defendants have failed to produce on record any convincing evidence to prove their possession. Counter claim filed by the defendants was also dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing for the appellants although made sincere attempt to persuade this Court to take a different view, however, could not draw attention of the Court to any substantive error or perversity in the judgment of the Courts below. Hence, there is no ground to interfere.

Dismissed.
