This order of mine shall dispose of abovementioned seven regular second appeals arising out of the same controversy.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised between the parties. By way of settlement, the parties have compromised in all the aforesaid seven appeals.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, the compromise decree, in terms of the report of the Mediator Ms. Kiran Bhardwaj, dated 14.03.2018 is passed. The report of the compromise, which is now exhibited as 'CX', is made part of the decree. The same will substitute to the decree passed by the Courts below.

All the aforesaid seven regular second appeals are, accordingly, disposed of, in terms of compromise Ex.'CX'. The parties will be bound by the said compromise.

Since, the main appeals have been disposed of, therefore, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
