Short question for consideration in the present appeal is whether appellant is entitled to enhanced compensation from Rs.1,00,000/- as ordered by the Appellate Court on 22.02.2013 or not.

Undisputedly, appellant was not allowed to discharge the duties of the post held by him during the month of September, 2009 to August, 2012 in view of the compulsory retirement order. For three years granting a sum of ₹ 1,00,000/- would be too meagre. Therefore, order of the Appellate Court granting compensation of ₹ 1,00,000/- is modified to ₹ 3,00,000/-. Modified compensation shall be paid to the appellant by the respondents within a period of 4 months from today failing which appellant is entitled to interest @ 6% per annum from today.

Appeal stands disposed of.
