The appellant has questioned the validity of orders passed by the disciplinary as well as appellate authority in a disciplinary proceedings. Both the courts below have affirmed the order passed in the disciplinary matter. Appellant has not made out a case with reference to any legal contention so as to interfere with the orders of the disciplinary as well as appellate authority. Time and again, Supreme Court has held that Court cannot re-appreciate evidence in a disciplinary proceedings.
