Counsel for the respondents would inform that the respondents-decree holders have already obtained possession of the premises in question in execution of decree dated 8.9.2017 passed by the trial court which was affirmed in appeal by the first Appellate Court and as such, present appeal may be disposed of having rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the appellant has conceded to this position but would state that Sandeep Kaur has been taken back for resumption of matrimony by her husband Vikram Pal Singh.

Counsel for the respondents would state that the respondents-decree holders are not concerned with resumption of cohabitation of Sandeep Kaur and the said issue is not relevant for the purpose of present lis.

In view of the above, appeal stands disposed having rendered infructuous but without prejudice to right of the appellant to avail

appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
