The present appeal directs challenge against concurrent findings recorded by the Courts whereby suit filed by Yug Dutt son of Ranjha Ram (since deceased) now represented by his LRs seeking partition of double storey house No.ND30, Bikrampura Mohalla, Jalandhar City on the basis of natural succession was allowed by the trial Court vide judgment and decree dated 21.01.2014 that came to be affirmed in appeal filed by defendants No.2 to 8 by the Additional District Judge, Jalandhar. The Courts have held that all the sons and daughters of Ranjha Ram became owner to the extent of 1/7th share in the suit property which is admittedly joint and has not been partitioned by metes and bounds.

Counsel for the appellant has failed to point out any materials on record in order to substantiate contention of the appellant that consistent findings recorded by the Courts suffer from an error much less perversity, warranting intervention.

For the foregoing reasons, the appeal fails and is accordingly dismissed in limine.
