

GURPREET SINGH MALHI V/S STATE OF PUNJAB AND ANR.

This petition was disposed of on 06.10.2017, thereby quashing the FIR subject to payment of costs of Rs.2,00,000/- to be deposited on or before 10.11.2017 in the Government Treasury. Thereafter, on miscellaneous application filed by the petitioner, the year of the FIR was corrected and again the time was extended up to 30.11.2017. Then another application was filed for certain correction and while allowing the same, the time was extended till 20.12.2017.

The trial Court/ Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Moga has submitted a report dated 24.01.2018 that in compliance of the order passed by this Court in CRM-M-36712-13 of 2017 and CRM-M-46218 of 2016, neither the petitioner has appeared nor has deposited the cost as per orders by this Court.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has placed on record the certified copy of the order dated 19.12.2017 passed by Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Moga that as per report of Nazar, petitioner - Gurpreet Singh Malhi has deposited the cost of Rs.2 lacs in the State Bank of India, Moga and the same has been entered in the decree / money register of the Nazar at Sr. No.10 dated 18.12.2017 and, thereafter, as the petitioner has complied with the order of this Court, the file was consigned to record room. Counsel for the petitioner has also placed on record the photocopy of the challan receipt, which has been cost of Rs.2 lacs.

In view of the above, registry is directed to send a copy of all these documents to the trial Court for compliance thereof and a report be sent if any further direction is required by this Court.
