It comes out that respondent has not appeared, despite service through his mother. Proceedings before the lower Court are lying stayed.

Petitioner seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Shiva Giri Versus Poonam Rani*, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Amloh (Punjab) to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Sirsa (Haryana).

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that at the time of filing of petition, two other cases i.e. one under Section 125 Cr.P.C. and other criminal complaint under Section 498-A IPC were pending at Sirsa Courts (Haryana). It is deemed proper that all the cases pending between the parties should be decided at one place. Therefore, petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as *Shiva Giri Versus Poonam Rani*, pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division),

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Amloh (Punjab) is withdrawn from that Court and same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Sirsa (Haryana), who may retain the case himself or entrust the same to any other Court of competent jurisdiction. Instant petition is allowed.
