Additional affidavit of G.S. Dhillon, Chief Manager Establishment, Punjab State Warehousing Corporation on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The application for reviewing the order dated 16.09.2016 (Annexure A-1) whereby CWP No.2843 of 2015 was disposed of and the applicant-petitioner was directed to furnish the security in terms of the order dated 15.03.2012 (Annexure P-10) passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court in CWP No.21042 of 2010, titled as ***“C.R. Sethi vs Punjab State Warehousing Corporation and another”***, within one month and thereafter the retiral benefits will be calculated and released within one month.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it comes out that applicant-petitioner C.R. Sethi has died and the respondents are insisting upon furnishing the guarantee.

I am of the view that whatever may be the reason, the reasoned order was passed. There is no error apparent on the face of the record. However, the respondents are ready to accommodate the applicant-petitioner and are ready to accept the surety of immovable property either by the legal heirs of the petitioner or by any third person to secure the amount in terms of the order dated 15.03.2012 passed in CWP No. 21042 of 2010.

As such, the present application stands disposed of.
