In compliance of the previous order dated 13.03.2018 passed by this Court, requisite affidavit has been filed by the appellant seeking therein for withdrawal of the appeal with a prayer to grant him six months' time to vacate suit property.

Heard.

Learned counsel appearing for the caveator- respondents has no objection in granting six months' time to the appellant to vacate the suit property.

In view of the aforesaid affidavit filed by the appellant, this appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. The appellant is granted six months' time from today to vacate the suit property, i.e. on or before 15.09.2018, failing which, he shall be liable to pay penalty @ ₹1,000/- per day towards use and occupation charges to the respondents No.2 to 4. That apart, the appellant shall also be liable for contempt of Court proceedings.

In the interest of justice, respondents are directed to pay ₹4,000/- to the appellant towards the value of the utensils of the appellant allegedly lying in the kitchen and after paying the same, the appellant shall have no right for claim whatsoever in the household articles.
