Learned counsel for respondent No.5 states that in pursuance of judgment dated 26.8.2016 passed by this Court, the Dispute Commission, Indian Olympic Association has resolved the dispute vide order dated 9.12.2018. The operative part of decision rendered by the Dispute Commissioner reads as under:-

“The Commission has reviewed the representation from 20 State units of Gymnastics, requesting the Indian Olympic Association to intervene and resolve the governance of Gymnastics in India. The Indian Olympic Association may convene a meeting of the General Council of GFI to re-establish its leadership in accordance to the National Sports Development Code (NSDCI), 2011, the Constitution of IOA and the GFI Constitution. To ensure that the decisions taken during the periods of confusion, regarding the authenticity of President and General Secretary's office does not undermine the representation of the Gymnastic units in the General Council, the India Olympic Association shall, without prejudice, include only the State units, that was in the electoral college of the GFI election held on 12th August 2015 as per the order of the Hon'ble High

Court of Delhi. The IOA shall implement this order within three (3) months.

If any of the parties have any objection to this order, they may appeal before the IOA Arbitration Commission within 15 days of receipt of the same.”

No further action is warranted in the matter.

Disposed of.

In view of the above, Indian Olympic Association is directed to take the final view in the matter within eight weeks from today. If any grouse still survives, the parties shall have the right to revive the present petition.
