In the present appeal, appellant has questioned the validity of trial and appellate courts judgments dated 18.3.2014 and 17.11.2016.

2. Appellant while working as a constable, he was dismissed from service on 09.02.1993. Consequently, he has invoked departmental remedy like filing of appeal and revision petition. His appeal was rejected on 6.8.1994. Thereafter, he was silent for about six years in filing revision petition i.e. upto 13.12.2000. His revision, even though, pending consideration for 7 long years. However, root of the matter is that there is inordinate delay and laches on the part of the appellant in filing revision petition before the revisional authority to the extent of 6 years. Therefore, rightly trial and appellate court refused to interfere with the revisional authority order. Thus, appellant has not made out a case so as to interfere with the orders passed by the courts below.

3. Accordingly, appeal stands dismissed.
