This is a regular second appeal filed by the unsuccessful employee-plaintiff against the concurrent findings of fact of the Courts below.

The order of compulsory retirement was passed by the Senior Regional Manager, therefore, it cannot be said that the same has been passed by an authority lower in rank than the appointing authority of the appellant. The Punishing/Competent authority to pass an order of compulsory retirement has to be regulated as per rules and distribution of powers therein. This is the only issue raised and none other was pressed. No question of law arises for determination in this appeal. Order to stand.

The appeal is dismissed.
