This order shall dispose of OLR No. 3 of 2016, OLR No. 6 of 2016, OLR No. 7 of 2016, OLR No. 8 of 2016, OLR No. 9 of 2016 and OLR No. 10 of 2016, in which the Official Liquidator has filed his report in terms of Section 497 (6) of the Companies Act, 1956 for final dissolution of the company, registered with the Registrar of Companies, Chandigarh/New Delhi, in members' voluntary winding up.

On 30.8.2016 and 20.9.2016, this Court had ordered the Official Liquidator to publish dissolution notice in two daily newspapers namely; 'The Indian Express' English and 'Punjab Kesri' (both Punjabi and Haryana Edition). The Official Liquidator was also directed to upload the dissolution notice on website of his office. In this regard, the Official Liquidator has filed affidavit dated 15.12.2016 stating that the publication has been carried out in 'Indian Express (English) and Punjab Kesri (Punjabi) (Punjab and Haryana Edition) on 1.11.2016 and notice has also been uploaded on website of his office but he has not received any objection from creditors/ workmen/ general public and

contributory.

It is further stated that as per record of his office neither any complaint nor objection has been received and the affairs of the company (in Member Voluntary Liquidation) have not been conducted in a manner prejudicial to the interest of its members or to public interest.

After taking the report filed by the Official Liquidator into consideration and perusing the documents available on record, I am satisfied that there is no reason whatsoever in law or on facts to deny the prayer for members voluntary winding up and dissolution of the company. Therefore, the applications are allowed and accordingly, the companies are ordered to be dissolved in members' voluntary winding up.
