The present judgment shall dispose of 5 Cross-objections, bearing XOBJR-3-CI-2016 IN RFA-10253-2014, XOBJR-4-CI-2016 IN RFA-10302-2014, XOBJR-5-CI-2016 in RFA-10303-2014, XOBJR-53-CI-2016 IN RFA-2448-2014 & XOBJR-208-CI-2015 IN RFA-2447-2014, filed by the HSIIDC.

The main appeals have been remanded to the Reference Court, on 20.03.2018, for fresh decision. However, the above-mentioned cross-objections which were ordered to be heard along with the main cases, were not listed. Accordingly, in view of the fact that the main appeals have been

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remanded, the present cross-objections have become infructuous and are disposed of, as such. It is, however, clarified that in the said order dated 20.03.2018, reference had been made that the appeals had been filed against various awards of the Reference Court but factum of Reference Court award dated 19.09.2014 for Village Sultanpur, was missed out. Accordingly, the same be also read in continuation of the earlier order.
