

Charan Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and another

For the facts and circumstances of the case, in CRM No.40969 of 2016, a compromise was arrived at between the petitioners Charan Singh and others as well as complainant-respondent No.2-Rishi Pal and in pursuance thereof, some amount was to be deposited in the shape of demand draft/bank draft which was to be paid to the complainant and the victims by the petitioners. However, vide order dated November 30, 2017 passed by this Court while disposing of CRM No.40969 of 2016, Registry was directed to return the drafts to the depositor i.e. the petitioners who were further directed to re-deposit the same in the Registry after its re-validation thereof within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Due to non-compliance of the aforesaid order, now this file has been put up for to achieve or accomplish the real intention of the parties vide order dated November 30, 2017, the petitioners were directed to visit the office of the Registrar, to obtain a bank/demand draft earlier furnished by them for making payment to respondent No.2-Rishi Pal. Instead of re-depositing the same in the office of the Registrar, petitioners are directed to make the payment of the aforesaid demand/bank draft(s) directly to respondent No.2-Rishi Pal(complainant), either against a proper receipt or to hand over the demand/bank draft(s) to him, after getting revalidation thereof.

The needful shall be done by the petitioners within a period of three weeks after having received back bank draft/demand draft from the office of the Registrar. At the same time, registry is also directed to hand over/return the bank drafts/demand drafts to the petitioners-Charan Singh etc.
