Appellants have questioned the validity of orders of trial as well as appellate courts dated 27.04.2015 and 01.04.2017 respectively. Name of the respondent was turned down by the appellants for the post of Assistant from Driver on the score that he do not fulfil one of the qualification prescribed for the post that one must be literate enough to read and write Hindi language. Trial court has taken note of the fact that respondent fulfil the qualification of reading and writing in view of the passing 5th Class examination in Hindi. Thus, there is no infirmity in the orders of trial as well as appellate courts dated 27.04.2015 and 01.04.2017 respectively.

Accordingly, appeal stands dismissed.
