

Ashok Kumar and Ors. Vs. Harphool

File has been put up by the office for seeking appropriate orders qua the cheque bearing No.525726 dated 07.3.2017 for Rs.3,333/- prepared in the name of “Omi” petitioner No.2.

On 30.11.2015, this Court allowed the revision petition while directing the respondent to be arrested and detained in civil prison for a period of one month. Thereafter, the review application was moved by the applicant-respondent and notice of the same was issued by this Court on 14.12.2015 subject to respondent depositing Rs.10,000/- to the credit of the case before the Registrar (General) on or before 23.12.2015. No reply to the application was filed and the same was allowed vide order dated 31.1.2017 by recalling order dated 30.11.2015. Amount of Rs.10,000/- deposited by the respondent was also ordered to be released in favour of the petitioners against proper receipt and after due verification of their identification.

It has been apprised by the office that as per the identity proof (copy of Adhar Card), the name of petitioner No.2 is, in fact, “Ompati Devi” whereas the cheque has been prepared in the name of “Omi” instead of “Ompati Devi”.

After perusing the contents of the note received from the Registry, it is ordered that the aforesaid cheque prepared in the name of petitioner No.2 shall be treated as cancelled and the matter be put up in this regard only when appropriate application for correction of the name of petitioner No.2 is filed.
