The present petition was allowed and FIR No.91 dated 4th November, 2011 registered under Section 452 and 323 read with Section 34 of the IPC at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Ferozepur along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 12th August, 2015 passed by the Ld. Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Abohar was quashed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 19th December, 2017 with a condition to deposit costs of Rs.10,000/- by the petitioners with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh within one week, failing which the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed and the matter was fixed for 8th January, 2018 i.e. today for production of receipt regarding deposit of costs.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioners has produced the original receipt dated 22th December, 2017 vide which an amount

of Rs.10,000/- as costs has been deposited with the Punjab Legal Services Authority, SAS Nagar through D.D. No.942011. Original receipt is taken on record.

In view of the above nothing survives in the present petition. As such, IO in CRM-M No.35613 of 2015 stands disposed off.
