With the concurrence of both the parties, the main
case is taken up today.

Main case

Defendant is in regular second appeal.

Notice of motion was issued on 17.02.2018.
Thereafter, compromise was effected between the parties on
08.10.2018 wherein it was recorded that after preparation of
farad badar, the same was given effect in the form of
sanctioning of mutation No.6045 on 18.01.2018 wherein shares
of the plaintiffs and the appellant-defendant were correctly

reflected.

In view of correction in the farad badar and sanctioning of consequent mutation No.6045 dated 18.01.2018, both the parties have amicably resolved their differences and the suit filed by the plaintiffs has to be treated to be withdrawn on the strength of aforesaid compromise.

The compromise was duly signed by the parties in the presence of Mr. Ashok Swaitch, Advocate and witness namely Surender.

Learned counsel for both the parties are *ad idem* that this appeal be disposed of in terms of compromise and the suit filed by the plaintiffs-respondents be treated to be withdrawn.

The application has been supported with the affidavit of Mahender Singh-respondent No.1 who is also Special Power of Attorney of Bijender and Narender- brothers of respondent No.1.

In view of aforesaid, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present appeal in terms of compromise. The compromise shall form part of the order.
