The learned counsel for respondent has stated that he has no objection if divorce petition is transferred from Gurgaon Courts to Rohtak Courts. However, he has contended that three cases between the parties are pending, out of which, two cases are pending at Rohtak Courts, details whereof are given below :-

1. FIR No. 0266 dated 28.9.2017, registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Lakhan Majra, District Rohtak, pending at Meham Courts
2. Application under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, titled as *Anuradha Versus Sandeep etc.* is already pending in Meham Courts,
3. Petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. pending in Rohtak Courts.

TA No. 1002 of 2017 (O/M)

In order to ensure that all cases pending between the parties are tried at one place, petition titled as *Sandeep Versus Anuradha*, filed under Section 13(1) (i-a) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, is withdrawn from Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Gurgaon, and same is transferred to Court of learned District Judge, Family Court, Rohtak. The cases pertaining to FIR No. 0266 dated 28.9.2017, registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Lakhan Majra, District Rohtak, and application under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, titled as *Anuradha Versus Sandeep etc.* already pending at Meham Courts, are withdrawn from Meham Courts and same are transferred to Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Rohtak, for disposal. Consequently, petition is allowed.
