Reply on behalf of respondent has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record.

Heard.

This is a petition filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for transfer of petition bearing No. HMA-24-2016, filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (Annexure P-1), titled as **'Vikas Kumar versus Sunita'** pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Judge, Ratia, exercising the powers of District Judge District Fatehabad (Haryana) to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Budhlada, District Mansa (Punjab).

Learned counsel for respondent has opposed the application on the ground that there is no much distance between Budhlada and Ratia.

However, considering that two cases filed by the petitioner i.e. one petition

filed under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and second complaint filed under Section 498-A/406 of the Indian Penal Code are pending at Budhlada Courts, District Mansa, it is deemed proper that all the cases should be tried at one place.

Therefore, petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (Annexure P-1), bearing HMA-24-2016 titled as '**Vikas Kumar versus Sunita**' pending in the Court of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Judge, Ratia, District Fatehabad (Haryana) is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Budhlada, District Mansa for disposal.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.

Since, the main petition has been allowed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, also stands disposed of.
