Respondent has not appeared, despite service.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Jatinder Singh vs Beant Kaur*”, pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Shri Muktsar Sahib, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Phul, District Bathinda.

Heard. Respondent has not appeared to oppose the petition.

It is stated that a case filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. between the parties is already pending at Phul Courts.

Considering the difficulty expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner and to ensure that all the cases pending between the parties should be tried at one place, the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Jatinder Singh vs Beant Kaur*”, pending in
