Heard.

Petitioner, who is defendant before the lower court in a suit for damages bearing No.CS247/2017, titled as “***Sumer Singh vs Smt. Sheetal and others***”, seeks transfer of case from the court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Tosham (Bhiwani) to District Courts, Narnaul (Kanina), District Mahendergarh.

It is claimed that there is distance of 110 Kms. between Tosham and Narnaul. It takes 2.30 hours to travel from Tosham to Narnaul, which is difficult for the petitioner. The petitioner has lodged an FIR under Sections 498-A, 406, 323 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Kanina against her husband (respondent) and his family members, in which all the accused were acquitted.

I am of the view that ordinarily the case should be tried by the court having jurisdiction. The mere distance and registration of a criminal case, is no ground to transfer the case.

As such, the present petition is dismissed.
