Respondent has been served through his brother but none has come present on his behalf. He is proceeded against ex parte.

Petitioner seeks transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as ***“Paramjit Singh vs Mandeep Passi”***, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Jalalabad to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

Heard.

It is stated that the petitioner is running a photostat machine at Faridkot. She has got two minor children. Therefore, it is difficult for her to travel from Faridkot to Jalalabad to pursue her case. The proceeding under Section 125 Cr.P.C. between the parties are also pending at Faridkot Courts.

Considering the entirety of the facts and circumstances and the difficulty expressed by the petitioner and the fact that none has come present to oppose the petition, the petition filed under Section 9 of the

Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “*Paramjit Singh vs Mandeep Passi*”, pending in the Court of learned Addl. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Jalalabad, is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the court of learned Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Faridkot.

As such, the present petition is allowed.
