KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 24 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of the case titled as **“Smt. Leelawati and another versus Smt. Sonia”** filed under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Jind.

It comes out that two minor daughters namely Jiya and Pawani are residing with the petitioner at village Ritouli, Tehsil Safidon, District Jind. Ordinarily, such cases should be tried at the place where the minor(s) are residing.

As such, the petition titled as **“Smt. Leelawati and another versus Smt. Sonia”** filed under the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 pending in the Court of learned District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge,

Jind who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.

Since, the main transfer petition is allowed, the miscellaneous application pending, if any, stands disposed of.
