This is a petition filed under Section 24 (1) of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908 for transfer of the petition titled as **'Jagjit Singh versus Rajveer Kaur'**, filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Tarn Taran to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has recently given birth to a male child and it is difficult for her to travel from Faridkot to Tarn Taran. It is further submitted that another application filed by the petitioner-wife under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is also pending before the Family Court at Faridkot. Therefore, it is requested that all the cases should be tried at one place.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petition titled as 'Jagjit Singh versus Rajveer Kaur', filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, pending in the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Tarn Taran is withdrawn from the said Court and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Faridkot who may retain the case himself or entrust it to any other court of competent jurisdiction for trial.

In view of above, petition stands allowed.
