It comes out that regarding the same accident, two claim petitions have been filed. The widow and minor son of the deceased have filed claim petition at Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra, whereas parents of the deceased filed another claim petition at Panchkula. Both the claim petitions are required to be decided by one Court.

Accordingly, the claim petition titled as Smt. Harvinder Kaur and another vs. Bajinder Singh and others pending in the Court of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Panchkula is withdrawn from the said Court and is transferred to the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Kurukshetra, where the other claim petition filed by the widow Sunita Rani and another vs. Baljinder Singh and others is pending.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
